

HANDLE SPECIAL HCC SITUATIONS

 A change to a very commonly reported condition is diabetes, which has decreased values in V28. Some categories are eliminated entirely. V28 assigns a risk score to 2,264 fewer diagnosis codes.



- CMS pays Medicare Advantage (MA) plans using Hierarchical Condition Categories (HCCs), and many private payers and ACOs use the HCC model for risk adjustment. This concept is critical as we move forward with quality in healthcare.
- Version 28 contains 10 HCCs for heart conditions. Angina codes, except for unstable type and supraventricular tachycardia, have been removed from being risk-adjusted.
- Understanding the recent changes and communicating effectively with your coders and physicians is critical to successfully documenting, coding and paying for risk adjustment. Now is an ideal time to review, and to educate coders, CDI teams and physicians on the recently enacted updates.
